# NACHIP

## The North American Curly Horse Inspection Program

Sponsored by ICHO

The NACHIP program is for inspecting ICHO registered Curly Horses. The inspection process is performed by approved ICHO judges. Horses are judged in three separate areas. These areas are of equal importance: **Conformation, Movement and Temperament**. These three area scores are added together to get a combined total score. Each horse is judged as a WTC (walk, trot, canter) horse or a Gaited (must show intermediate soft gait/s) horse. All types of Curlies from pony to drafty are welcome. They are inspected as an individual regardless of Curly type in the same 3 areas: conformation, movement and temperament.

Traditionally NACHIP inspections have been held at AGM's (Annual General Meeting, ICHO's yearly convention). Individuals may also hold an inspection if they have enough interest in their area to cover judges expenses (judges fee, travel, hotel and meals). The inspection fee at AGM's is traditionally \$60.00 per horse, this may vary at individual NACHIP inspections held. For information about holding a NACHIP inspection, please see the webpage <http://ichocurlyhorses.org> under INSPECTIONS for more details. Horses presented for inspection must present a copy of their ICHO/NACHR registration papers before inspection.

Curlies that receive a score of: Stallions 70% and higher, Mares 60% and higher and are DNA typed, will be accepted into the:

**INTERNATIONAL CURLY APPROVED MARE and STUDBOOK or ICAMS** as it is know as. ICAMS is a database of inspected approved Curly horses that have the required inspection score and are DNA typed. We are waiving the \$5.00 recording fee and all inspected horses with the required score will be accepted into the database with proof of DNA typing. These inspection Scores will be listed along with the horses name, reg# and possibly a photo on our webpage in the future.

The entire inspection program is to help educate owners in knowing the quality of their horses and what area they may excel in. This is also very helpful in knowing the breeding quality of a Curly. The conformation of a horse will affect the movement and the ability to stay sound. The movement a horse shows will tell what area he/she may excel in (Western, Sport, Gaited, Pleasure, etc). Temperament must be good so the horse and human partner can work together safely and in harmony.

At ICHO we want the best for the Curly horse and their owners and through NACHIP inspections we hope to educate and help owners and Curlies be all they can be.

If your horse is pending registration, that means you have already paid for registration and your paperwork is already in the ICHO office or with the registrar. No last minute registration submissions allowed because of time limits and deadlines to have the calendar finished on time. If you have a horse you would like to submit photos of that is not registered yet, the registrations & payment must be submitted **before** the calendar page payment deadline of May 1st.

**Photo requirements:** All photos must be of clear good quality at least 1000 x 800 size in PNG format. \*If you design your own page, finished size must be 2300 x 1800 in PNG format with at least a 1 inch area/border with no text so it does not get cut off during printing. Text required is your horse/s name, reg#, your contact info, including web page, email and optional is type of breeding program. 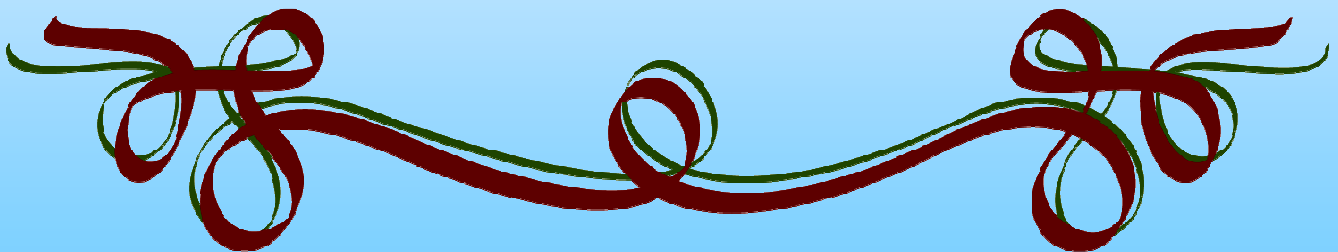

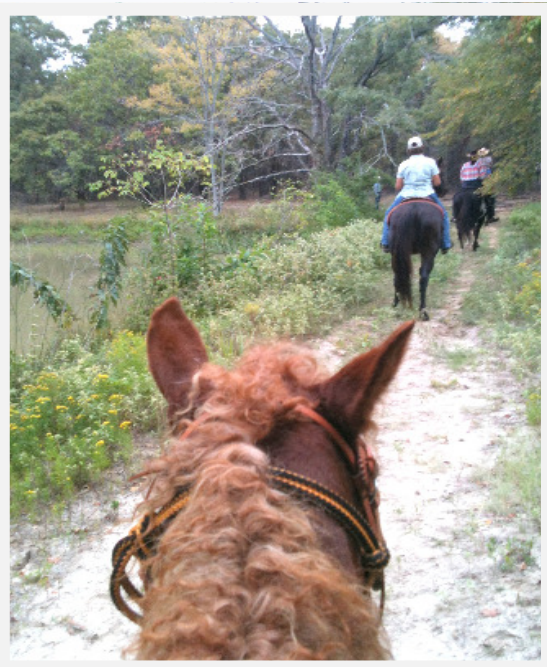


American Competative Trail Horse Association ride. Remegait Chesterfield, ICHO 1203-D and Angie Gaines, on their first ACTHA ride donation to a local therapeutic center.

The sun was just peeking out behind the morning clouds and all the animals were feed. I haltered Chester and we walked to the waiting trailer to begin our first American Competative Trail Horse Association ride at Lake Tawakoni, Quinlan, Texas. We drove over an hour before we reached the beautiful East Texas lake but when we pulled in we knew we were at the right place as there were horse trailers of every color and size. Chester stood patiently while I checked in and grabbed our number, 111. I chatted with a friend who had attended our Western Dressage clinic the weekend before and noticed her beautiful Trakenker, Beau, was saddled and ready to go so I quickly saddled Chester and prepared for our ride.

Sporting his saddle and new breast collar, Chester and I walked around and admired all the beautiful horses. Folks were so friendly and everyone was curious about Chester's curls. Most ladies couldn't resist touching his mane and Chester stood gentlemanly truly enjoying his admirers. Soon, we were on the trail. I quickly read the obstacle sheet, our first one was trotting over ground poles, next dragging a log while trotting, then backing ten steps between trees, the water obstacle had been closed to due wild pigs playing in it the night before and causing large holes...but the one I was sure we would master was side passing to the gate and opening it. Chester and I always went last as we were not only the only Curly horse we were the only Stallion on the ride. We started our side pass and things were going great and then Chester immediately sidepassed in the other direction. Our dear friend and Beau were in front of us as our group approached a bee hive in the ground. Several of the horses started to buck and her Beau spooked and my friend landed on the ground with a broken ankle. Beau ran wildly through the woods but Chester was calm and cool and we followed to make sure Beau was safe and took his saddle off so he did not get hung up in the trees. Whew, I asked if that was extra points{:> Chester and I will be attending our second ACTHA ride next Saturday and we are hoping to bring a friend along who will be riding Jett, our four year old Curly who is Chester's half brother. ## **New ICHO Show Awards Program for 2013**

Each category separated out more in the manner of the USDF, USEF, and other horse organizations to build more credence for the show awards as each discipline is very much its own. The following rules proposed are much the same as any other show award given by the different horse organizations. This lays the ground work to build a stronger recognition and at some point become a participating organization for a USDF all breeds award along with ICHO's show awards providing more credence to the registry as a whole and the curly breed.

**All scores need to be sent in to the office no later than 30 days after the show**, the last show results must be in the office no later than Dec 31. This is so the scoring and recording can be done in a timely fashion.

### **Use Show Award Application Form for:**

**Dressage**-send in front page of score sheet with score, an average will be taken of all the tests at the end of the show year. Person needs to have at least 3 tests but can have more.

**Endurance**- Times and score will be sent in and again an average of all will be taken at the end of the show year.

**Eventing**- send in total score for the entire event, at least 3 scores necessary average taken for highest score.

**Driving Dressage**-front page of tests sent in and an average will be taken at the end of the year. At least 2 tests need to be done.

**Combined Driving**-Average taken of scores.

**After your initial application has been submitted and payment, you can then send copies of your score sheets thereafter, be sure horses name, ICHO/NACHR# and your name are included.**

### **Use Show Award Points Form for:**

**All classes in 4H or Open Shows**- Place in class with points given depending on place value by ICHO so higher placing mans more points. Similar to what is being done now.

**Barrel Racing**-Times of each race will be averaged together at the end of the year. At least 3 barrel races need to be done.

Cost for participating in each award area will remain at \$5 per horse. Each horse needs to be a registered ICHO horse and Owner needs to be ICHO current member, if rider is not a member, Award goes to ICHO member horse owner.

**Sunny Martin Youth Scholarship**- same program we have for Junior Members in ICHO.



## **Andrea Schaap Memorial Adult Scholarship “New program for Adults”**

\$250 dollars awarded to an ICHO member adult rider for having attended education clinics/lessons in any discipline on a registered curly horse. The purpose would be to strengthen the rider’s ability to best show the capabilities of a curly horse when competing in open breed competition. Those interested would need to apply by writing a small essay on how receiving this scholarship would help themselves, their horse, the breed as a whole and what have they done thus far to promote or improve themselves and horse in their chosen discipline. Support should be given to those who are not doing specific breed demos or parades but instead those who are competing against other breeds in open competition. Award money to help defray cost of attending these educational clinics/lessons for the year.

1 scholarship will be provided each year and if enough interest shown, fundraising will be done to increase this number.

Many of the riders/owners of the curly horse are adults who have begun showing again or for the first time in their life and are already working with individuals to strengthen their ability. They are not doing breed demos or parades but instead competing in open breed competitions in a specific discipline showing that the curly horse is just as capable as any other breed. We as owners already know the curly can do well against other Curlies but the general public still does not know or necessarily believe the breed has the ability to compete against all other breeds and do well. This scholarship fund will provide the support needed to move beyond breed demos and parades into the larger horse population stepping up the exposure of the curly horse increasing its sale ability and perception to the general public who are looking for and paying good money for safe capable horses.

Through this scholarship fund the ICHO will be able to show current ICHO members, riding their ICHO registered Curlies, that it is a registry that supports the efforts of its riders and horses in promoting the curly horse against other breeds. It will also be able to demonstrate that it is a forward thinking registry that is working to be as strong as many of the large horse organizations such as the USEF and USDF.
