DCHO Member Curly Horse Featured Farm by Audree Daigle, Canada

Les Ecuries Rafaele Curly

Les Ecuries Rafaele Curly is a small North American Curly breeding home located in Bas-

Caraquet, New-Brunswick, Canada. I would like to share our experience in our relationship with Curlies, Some of our foals are on this page.

Like many people I was always drawn to horses; their freedom and power intoxicated me. Sadly it was not possible for me to have a horse because I was very allergic. My allergy to horses was very severe; caused serious asthma attacks, difficulty breathing, hives,





swelling, difficulty swallowing, even after taking medication to prevent allergies.

As destiny would have it, horses crossed my path again, when we took possession of a farm in order to expend our dog

breeding program, and to start cattle breeding. We did end up keeping some horses for family members, and this just brought back the dream of having my own horses, without ending up in the emergency room. When I learned that there were some hypoallergenic horses, I started my research right away.

My first encounter with a curly was Sonnen (above and below), a young 2 years old paint filly, at Ranch T-Boucly. We traveled 16hrs to visit her. A month later, we repeated the long journey to



bring this young filly home. This began a long friendship and passion. Not just between my filly and I, but between us and the family of Ranch T-Boucly. We quickly caught their passion for the breed, and they became our advisors. In less than a year, we returned to their ranch numerous times, to visit and share our passion for breeding Curlies.



My first impression of this young filly Sonnen, was her admirable confidence, despite her young age, She seemed to be bombproof of everything, nothing seemed to phase her. She was curious and brave, which was unlike what I thought I knew of horses. She was not like other horses. All the new experiences that could make a horse timid, she did it like it was nothing new: trailer loading, taking her first rider, her first trail ride, her first meeting with a vet and so on. Another trait was how attentive and affectionate she was with us, a real pot of glue... always wanted our attention, always waiting for us at the gate. She preferred spending time with us rather than being with other horses. Never wanting to miss out, she would run up to you, from the Never field, to make



sure you would choose her (right).

My horse allergy is about 80 % better with Curlies, and I've also developed a tolerance to other non-Curly horses that live among us. I do still need to limit my contact with the non-Curlies. Now, my worst allergy trigger seems to be horse manure, cleaning the stable was the most difficult task for me. My horses enjoy an outside life in the field with running shelter, it's better for their health and for mine. I still had some little skin rashes from some of my curly horse's saliva, but it's a minimal reaction, the most

important thing for me is that I can breathe around them. Above left, RC Spirit Amigo de Cypress Lady, passing his Dun Colors and his friendly personality to his offspring, Spirit was an amazing stallion.



Later on, we met Sterling Silver, a great Curly Stallion, very intelligent, playful, with great offspring. We decided to own one of his sons and become Curly breeders, to share our passion for this incredible horse and allow other allergic people to have their dream come true. Sterling Curlies, like Ranch T-Boucly, were also a great help in our process to become Curly breeders and sharing some experience in raising Curlies.

Our breeding stock comes from diversified and foundation blood lines, including Damele and Cypress, as well as from the legendary stallion blood line **Spartacus* to produce athletic, healthy, good confor-



mation and sporthorse curly. But our main goals in breeding are to produce an amazing horse personality a (people lover) horse with a lot of willing spirit.

Curly horses are easy to train. They are calm, intelligent, confident and easy going. We use

natural horsemanship methods to train and ride our curly horses and they are all taught basic manners as foals. Me and my Curlies tried and performed in a lot of disciplines, such as barrel racing, gymkhana, jumping, trail, English and western shows. But we had a preference for dressage and we are now putting our energies in that discipline. Most Curlies share a very nice riding look with those flying step. My Curlies are also great beginners riding class horse and are a very calm and confident trail horses. Like a lot of Curly owners . we are riding our Curlies bitless and enjoy the connection and the trust we have in each other.

On this page is RC Alfy Picola de Sterling silver We are very proud of our main Stallion; personality, conformation and colorful! Sharing a life with a horse is a passion, it's a way of life, and Curlies have made my dream come true !







God must have blessed our early decisions on

OUT choices of horses and breeding stallions as we couldn't have been happier with the babies we have had over the years here at Three Feathers. We really had no plans of taking on owning our own stallion, but we hit the mark, first time out, with our very first stud colt, Nagi, pictured right, (TFN Nagi Hanhepi Wi To, ICHO #1378) and he became our herd stallion. He was so perfect in every way with his beautiful conformation, strikingly handsome black and white



tobiano coloring and awesome personality. He is simply stunning, has a proud spirit about him and such a sweet boy! He has given us many beautiful curly babies over the years and we are looking forward to many more including 2 new beautiful babies this spring! Many people have hard time believing the stories we tell of him sometimes, not believing a stallion can be so calm and so well-behaved. Like the story of when we were first training him to ride. We had done ground work with him in the arena 2, maybe 3 times. At the end of those sessions, Louis got on his back and just sat on

him for a few minutes to get him used to someone being on his back, which he was perfectly fine with right from the very first time. On his second and third sessions, Louis made him walk a just a few steps around the arena and he did great – so calm and willing. By his 4th

session, he was doing so well and Louis was so confident of him, he threw the lead rope around his neck and tied it to Nagi's halter to make reins (No bits on our farm – all are ridden bit-less) and took off on him for a

ride around the farm – bareback. Not a minutes problem out of him, you would have thought he had been ridden for years. And there are so many more. He is extremely calm, willing and obedient. Even when time for breeding the girls, he is easy to handle and does as we ask him too. He is a very smart and sensible guy too. He also has a wonderful curious and playful personality as well. He is like a big puppy dog – he will follow us every step we make and try to "help" with any project we are working with around the farm. I think he would ride the bush hog behind the tractor if we would let him. :-)

Everyone who visits the farm is always in awe of all the horses, but especially of Nagi and how sweet and calm he is which is totally unexpected from a stallion by most people. We can't say enough good things about Nagi and are so honored to have him in our lives as part of the

family here at Three Feathers. He has passed these wonderful traits on to his offspring as well and many have went on to other wonderful homes across the country and even the globe. To date we have yet to geld any colts as they have all went on to be breeding stallions in other programs themselves. It has been hard to part with them all, and I shed tears as I watch each of them leave our farm. But,

if we can help make others dreams with horses come true, like they did for me, it is a blessing! They are all special, but, some you realize you just cannot bear

the thought of ever leaving! Like our Cikala who went all the way to England, but through miraculous circumstances came back home to us last summer. Don't think I could bear to ever part with her again! And little Cica that came with her, the first foal out of our Tahalo in England –

we are so lucky to have her with us now too! And our little Zaska born here last year – she is one unique little gal! A grulla dun pinto with blue eyes and has such a sweet fun personality! But, if we keep these beautiful girls, we can't breed them to our stallion since he is their sire, or to Katee our beautiful black mare who is Nagi's dam. Al is an option, and we have done it before successfully, but so much trouble and expense. What to do about this dilemma?! We certainly in our wildest imagination never thought we would have more than one stallion on the farm. But, once again the love of these horses has led us down a different path than we had ever planned or expected. Last year we had the wonderful opportunity to add a beauti-

ful little stud colt to the herd and we

went for it!! Cahota is a smoky black (black with a crème gene) and while we love this time with them when they are youngsters, we can hardly wait for him to mature to be old enough to breed back to some of our lovely girls out of our Nagi!! My mind races with the possibilities!! Adding one stud colt was like adding 4 new mares to our program! These beautiful sweet girls can now stay with us and add to our breeding program! Smiles and happy dance all around!!! With his sweet and calm personality, his great build and family lines plus his black coloring along with the crème gene to add to our colorful mix of pintos and buckskin girls -my mind races with the fun possibilities!! I can hardly wait!!



And so, the blessings and changes in life's path these amazing horses have brought into our lives still continue and we are truly thankful for each day with them. They have blessed our lives in so many ways, and even the lives of many others as well. We have also made wonderful dear friends from all over the globe through them that we cherish. Yes, they came into our lives due to my allergies. And since that is the case, I will consider my allergies a blessing! When telling people about curly horses and our experiences with them, I ALWAYS tell them that, yes, their unique curly coats are wonderful and the fact that they are hypoallergenic is amazing and dream ful-

filling.....BUT, even if I did not have any allergies, after having had this breed, they are the ONLY breed for our family because their personalities are the most amazing thing about them!! 
